FUN IN THE SUN BEACH CAMP – Mrs. Thompson – *4 & 5 y/o*

Students will experience all of the fun that a day at the beach will bring! They will explore the animals of our oceans, create colorful crafts and read interesting books about the beach. They will end the week with a movie under the stars, a water play day and beach bash celebration! Max. 12

CAMP FIRESIDE READERS – Mrs. Stroh – *Going into Grades 1 & 2*

Welcome to Camp Fireside Readers where stories glow and young readers grow. This engaging reading camp is designed for rising 1st and 2nd graders. Each day, campers will gather “around the campfire” for read-alouds and build literacy skills through hands-on learning stations and friendly team challenges -- all while enjoying the magic of summer camp fun. CURTAIN CALL: BEGINNING BALLET CAMP – Ms. Pryor – *Going into Grades 1-5*

This camp is a four-day introductory ballet camp designed for young dancers with little to no prior ballet experience, as well as students seeking additional foundational training. Campers will receive age-appropriate instruction in basic ballet technique, including proper posture, alignment, stretching, strengthening, and introductory choreography. Each day incorporates structured movement activities alongside creative games and simple crafts to reinforce learning and keep dancers engaged. The camp concludes with a short, informal recital on the fourth day, giving campers the opportunity to demonstrate the skills and choreography they have learned in a supportive performance setting. Pretty Pieces Workshop is a fun, hands-on camp where creativity shines!
