Each day incorporates structured movement activities alongside creative games and simple crafts to reinforce learning and keep dancers engaged. The camp concludes with a short, informal recital on the fourth day, giving campers the opportunity to demonstrate the skills and choreography they have learned in a supportive performance setting.
